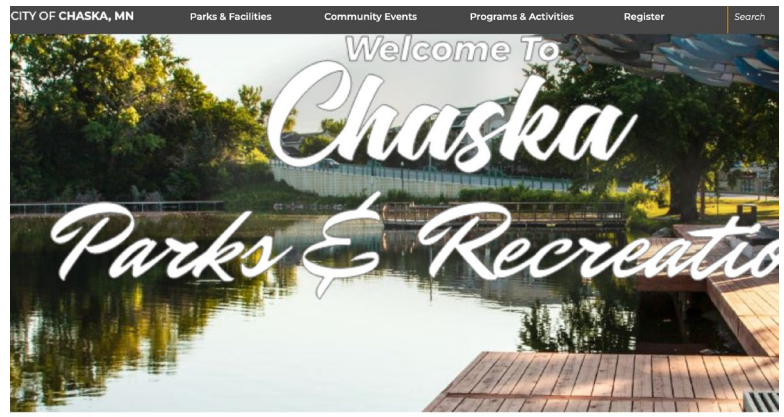

INCLUSION SUPPORT

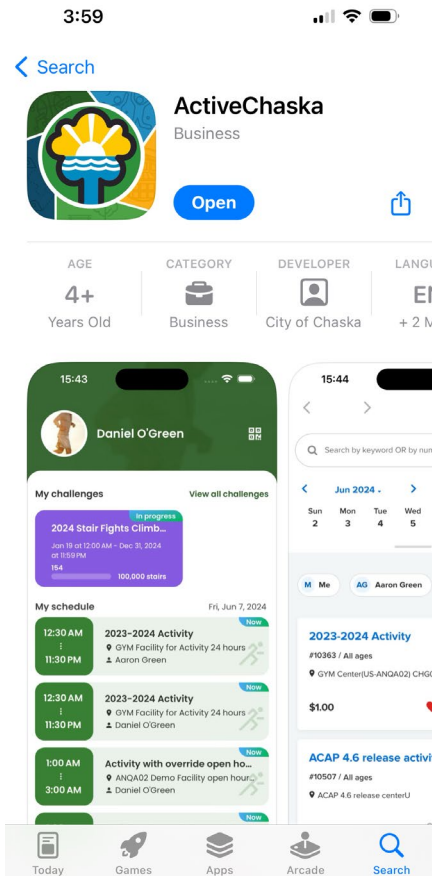
